At the meeting held in June 2011, we examined the merits of each of the ten proposed venue areas provided in response to an emailed request during 2010. The Planning Team are grateful to everyone who responded and each proposal was fully considered.

Healthy debate occurred as each proposed area was examined for its suitability from every angle. When the original ten were whittled down to the most likely four, a show of hands vote was taken, which resulted in a very clear majority decision.

Therefore, as advised in the previous newsletter, the City of **YORK**, UK, is the properly elected venue area for the reunion, to be held during April 2013.

Despite your own possible disappointment of chosen area, please bear in mind that this forthcoming 50th celebration in 2013 may be the last re-union of the type we have previously enjoyed. Therefore, this is "**THE ONE**" that we hope you all will make every effort to attend.

This newsletter is to update you all about the Planning Team's further deliberations of details for the reunion and other news.

Note: In selecting this date and venue, the Planning Team have examined and compared all relevant factors including, especially, the costs of the meal, the venue and venue accommodation, in both mid-week and weekend conditions.

Dress code: Gentlemen - Black Tie optional / Lounge Suit minimum  
Ladies - Posh Frocks & crown jewels

The Reunion function will be in a style commensurate with the occasion, similar to those we have enjoyed previously, and as usual, is open to all family members, subject to children age limit of 16 years, no younger please. This Reunion is also especially open to the Widows & families (16 or older) of our deceased members.

Could everyone please actively encourage those members and widows/families of deceased members who are known to you, to attend this reunion. Let us all try to make this occasion the best yet. Thank you.

### **Meet and Greet**

A suitable venue has yet to be chosen for a Meet & Greet (probably between 11.00am - 3.00pm on 10th April 2013) and will be advised at a later date.

## **Reunion Dinner Menu**

In the past, our Reunion dinner has given choices of starter, main course and sweet. However, on this occasion, the Reunion Dinner will be a sit-down meal with a set menu, which is a deviation from our norm, but a cheaper option.

This is considered to be the best solution, in the current economic climate, considering the costs and logistics involved etc and will preclude you having to decide what you want to eat 15 months in advance, as in the past.

In reaching this decision, the Planning Team have studied the hotel's sample menu lists and proposed a menu similar to the following example.

Starter:	Leek & Potato Soup *
Main:	Medallions of Lamb, Venison & Beef * with potatoes and vegetables
Sweet:	Crème Brulee / Raspberry Coulis *
	Coffee & Truffles *
	Table Cheese Board & Port **

**Nota Bene:** It is emphasised at this stage, that the above is an example only until we have confirmed with the Hotel that this menu is acceptable. The actual menu will be related later.

\* It is anticipated that the cost of the meal, per person, will be approximately £35.00 (TBD).

\*\* The Table Cheese Board and Port will be an additional extra, funded from the Entry Fund.

## **The Park Inn Hotel, York**

The 3\*/ 4\* Park Inn Hotel, North Street, York. YO1 6JF, (previously known as the Viking Moat House Hotel) has been chosen because it offers the best overall solution for our reunion requirements. We think this is the best compromise between venue elegance, function room availability, dinner and accommodation comfort and proximity to other hotel or B&B establishments.

To paraphrase the hotel's internet description, the Park Inn Hotel is a vibrant city centre hotel located in the centre of York. The hotel's 200 stylish and comfortable guest rooms includes Standard, Riverview and Business Friendly rooms and feature 24-hour room service, air conditioning, flat-screen 26" digital TVs and complimentary use of their Health and Fitness Club. This is the largest hotel in York, just a five-minute walk from York Train Station and is near shopping districts and major tourist attractions.

### **Accommodation at The Park Inn Hotel, York**

Standard per-room rates at this Hotel are; mid-week circa £100.00+ and weekends circa £160.00+. The following accommodation rates are offered for our Reunion:

Room Upgrade    £20.00 extra per night for Minster/River views

**N.B.** These prices are the best value for money noted during venue investigations and are current for 2011/2012 period. Please remember that there may be an increase for 2013 (possibly in the region of 5-10%).

**Alternative Accommodation:** York has a plethora of alternative accommodation at over 250 hotels, Travel Lodge, Premier Inn, B&B's and guest houses - all bookable via the Visitor Information Centre (+44 (0) 1904 550099; Email: [visityork.org](mailto:visityork.org); [www.visityork.org](http://www.visityork.org)) who can advise you.

### **Accommodation Booking**

If you are planning to attend the reunion, whatever accommodation package you choose for yourselves, it is strongly recommended that you make your booking as soon as you can. Please bear in mind that York is non seasonal and very popular with tourists all year round.

If opting for the Park Inn Hotel, to ensure you get the negotiated package, please quote:

A credit Card number is sufficient to secure a room booking at the Park Inn Hotel.

**DEPOSIT REQUIRED PLEASE:** Please be aware that the Planning Team has paid out a substantial deposit (greater than current funds) to secure the larger of two function rooms, which is dependent on numbers attending. To provide confidence to the Planning Team of your probable attendance and justify the advance expenditure, would you all please show your commitment and forward a minimum £10.00 per person non-refundable deposit as soon as possible to:

Alternative accommodation may be cheaper still.

Nevertheless, if you have concerns that these costs may be a bit out of reach, we may be able to offer a little help. We have limited Entry funds available which we intend to use at this function and which could be used to help.
